

Terms of acceptance concerning scrap tyres of all Genan plants

The Genan principle

Recycling of scrap tyres – forward-looking, professional and eco-friendly.

Information according the company

Genan drives a, according to the Federal Emission Control Law, approved scrap tyres recycling plant for material recycling (**no** thermal utilisation) of scrap tyres. The European Waste Code (EWC) is 160103, referred to the R03-method.

The following conditions apply to the acceptance of scrap tyres:

1. Before the unloading the supplier has to contact the employee at the weighbridge to hand out a filled out and signed consignment note.
2. The tyres must not be dirty, i. e. they must not be contaminated with soil, mud, colour, stones or other foreign matters.

The following types of scrap tyres are accepted for recycling:

Car-, pickup-, truck-, motorbike- as well as tractor-(AS) tyres without the rims **up to 150 x 60 cm**.

The delivery of tractor-tyres greater than 150 x 60 cm and all earth moving machine- (EM) tyres can only take place separately and by a written price and delivery arrangement.

Deliveries which include single pieces of AS-tyres greater than 150 x 60 cm and/or EM-tyres, will be calculated with 30,00 € for each tyre in addition to the agreed price per ton. This also applies as the case may be to costs for sorting on a time and material basis.

The acceptance of the following types of tyres will be declined:

- frazzled and tyres in pieces,
 - solid tyres
 - foam-filled tyres
 - bicycle- and barrow tyres
 - canvas and inner tubes
 - burnt tyres
 - as well as tyres on rims
3. The scrap tyres must show the above mentioned quality so that they can directly be dumped into the pit.
 4. There will be a weighing onto the calibrated in-house weighbridge before and after every dumping. The supplier will get a copy of the weight slip which is the basis for the invoice.
 5. Genan reserves the right to refuse the delivery or to stop the acceptance when deliveries do not comply with the above mentioned requirements.
 6. **Genan is authorised to charge additional costs, caused due to a breach of the above mentioned conditions (sorting 40,00 € per man-hour, 80,00 € per machine hour, disposal fees on a time and material basis), to the supplier.**
 7. Special or subsidiary agreements must be in written form.

Proof of the disposal:

- Delivery is only allowed with a consignment note (can be compiled pre-filled).
